

Crowd Q Stand Instruction

Unpack and assemble one unit at a time.

1. Select one of the **Uprights**. The **Upright** has a short aluminum tube attached to it's side. Slide the **Upright** over one of the two **Base** bushing, making sure to align the hole in the **Upright** with the hole in the **Base** bushing. Choose which bushing and hole to use depending on which direction you would like the Crowd Q Stand to face once assembled (for more info see Step 5).
2. Repeat for the second **Upright**, sliding it over the **Base** bushing of the second **Base** (different base than the first upright).
3. Locate the other tubes. Each end of each tube is numbered. Connect 1 to 1, 2 to 2, and so on, continuing until the entire stand is assembled. To assemble two sections, line up two tubes with the same number, depress the spring button, slide the other tube over the spring button and align the hole until the spring button pops through the second tube.
4. Slide the **Graphic** over the assembled Crowd Q Stand to complete assembly. If your graphic has a zipper or hook loop on the bottom, close the graphic around the bottom crossbar. Each Crowd Q Stand can be used individually, or to create continuous walls and 90 degree corners.
5. To assemble larger walls, assemble the next Crowd Q Stand, and instead of attaching to a fresh **Base**, attach one upright to the 2nd **Base** bushing (orienting it's position based on your preference) of the **Base** used by a prior stand. Make sure to screw all **Uprights** into the **Base** bushings steps 1-4. Repeat this for all additional Crowd Q Stands.
